# **Confessing our Brokenness and Opening Prayer**



# Gospel Luke 13:31-35

Yet today, tomorrow, and the next day I must be on my way, because it is impossible for a prophet to be killed outside of Jerusalem.' Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the city that kills the

and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.


